5. DIRECTIONS

Finding the Mountain Lion Field at the Four Diamonds Complex

Heading east from I-25 & Garden of the Gods, continue on until you reach Nevada Avenue. Here you will turn left and head north about half a mile. The Four Diamonds Complex is located on the right side of the road just north of Eagle Rock Road. There are no parking restrictions here except for no overnight parking.

Finding the Leon Sports Complex

1. From **I-25** exit 139, east on **US-24/Fountain Blvd** (2.5 miles) to **Alvarado Dr.**
2. South (right) on **Alvarado Dr** to **Leon Young Sports Complex.**

6. PARKING

FOUR DIAMONDS SPORTS COMPLEX VISITOR PARKING

The Four Diamonds Sports Complex can be used for general parking at no charge and is the location to park for softball. Overnight parking at the Four Diamonds Sports Complex is prohibited and vehicles parked as such will be fined/towed. Ample parking is available at Leon Young Sports Complex.

7. ADMISSION TO THE 2009 RMAC SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

8. ADDITIONAL VENUE INFORMATION

Portable restrooms will be available at both venues. A concession stand will be available at Leon Young Sports Complex (no concession stand will operate at Mountain Lion Field). **Dogs, as well as pets of any kind, are not allowed at either venue AT ANY TIME.** By RMAC rule, the use of artificial noise makers is prohibited.

9. SEATING INFORMATION

There is plenty of seating at Mountain Lion Field, but at Leon Young Sports Complex, seating is limited (first-come, first-served). It is recommended that spectators bring lawn chairs to this venue.
